Policies

1. Dr. Sineath gave an interim report on a proposal to streamline the Curriculum approval process to the new members of Council. This proposal entails moving all curriculum proposals except new programs directly from the College councils to Senate Council. Council members raised concerns about the amount of time it would take Senate Council to vet items, the absence of infrastructure and staff for curricular affairs at the Senate level, and coverage for curricular affairs in the summer months. After discussion, it was decided that the streamlining committee would write up a final version of the proposal for circulation to Graduate

Council members. Because of the gravity of this proposal, it will be formally voted on at the next meeting of Graduate Council, after the members have had time to consider its implications.
