A. GRADUATE FACULTY APPOINTMENTS

1. Prof. Jackson presented and made the motion to approve a request from the College of Business and Economics to appoint Dr. Blair Kidwell as a full member of the Graduate Faculty. The motion was seconded by Prof. Porter and unanimously approved

B. POLICY CHANGES

1. Prof. Jackson presented a request from the College of Public Health to permit three professional-level (DPH) courses to count toward the Master's in Public Health degree. Prof. Berry made the motion to deny the request. The motion was seconded by Prof. Pauly and unanimously approved.

2. Prof. Jackson presented the request from the College of Pharmacy to waive the GRE requirement for Pharm-D residents who apply for admission to either the Pharmaceutical Outcomes and Policy or the Medical Science master's programs. Prof. Pauly made the motion to table the proposal pending further discussion within the College of Pharmacy. The motion was seconded by Prof. Royse and unanimously approved.

C. PROGRAM PROPOSALS

1. Prof. Coyne provided an overview of the proposed new Integrated Ph.D and Master's Programs in Plant and Soil Sciences. Prof. Pauly made a number of suggestions to improve clarity of the proposal but subsequently made the motion to approve. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.
2. Prof. Jackson presented the rationale behind the proposal to change the name of the Natural Resource Conservation and Management (NRCM) program to Natural Resources and Environmental Science (NRES) program, and as a consequence to change the course prefix from NRC to NRE. Prof. Jackson made the motion to approve the proposal; the motion was seconded by Prof. Fox and unanimously approved.

D. COURSE PROPOSALS

1. PPS 704: Pharmacy Informatics. This proposal was tabled at the April 29 meeting of Graduate Council pending further clarification of the rationale for assigning either two or three credit hours to enrolled students. Prof. Pauly provided the requested information, made a motion to un-table, and approve the proposed new course. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.
2. RC 530: Cultural Diversity in Rehabilitation Counseling. This proposal was tabled at the April 29 meeting of Graduate Council pending further clarification of the justification for the credit hour change. Prof Jackson provided the requested information and made a motion to un-table and approve this course change. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.
3. IEC 558: Special Topics in Interdisciplinary Early Childhood. This proposal was originally approved at the April 29 meeting of Graduate Council contingent on consent of the program to change the course from 500 to 600-level. Prof. Jackson presented further information from the program in support of it remaining a 500-level course, and made the motion to remove the contingency and approve this new course as IEC 558. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.

4. IPS 610: Trans-Disciplinary Communication in Integrated Plant and Soil Sciences. Prof. Pauly presented and made the motion to approve this new course. The motion was seconded by Prof. Lee-Post and unanimously approved.
5. IPS 625: Trans-Disciplinary Research in Integrated Plant and Soil Sciences. Prof. Pauly presented and made the motion to approve this new course. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.
6. EE 535: Power Systems: Operation and Control. Prof. Heath presented and made the motion to approve this new course. The motion was seconded by Prof. Lee-Post and unanimously approved.
7. EE 536: Power System Fault Analysis and Protection. Prof. Heath presented and made the motion to approve this new course. The motion was seconded by Prof. Lee-Post and unanimously approved.
8. EE 555: Introduction to Micro-/Nano-Electromechanical Systems. Prof. Heath presented and made the motion to approve this new course. The motion was seconded by Prof. Fox and unanimously approved.
9. EE 570: Fundamentals of Nanoelectric Devices and Materials. Prof. Heath presented and made the motion to conditionally approve this new course pending completion of the course request form (inclusion of a course description). The motion was seconded by Prof. Pauly and unanimously approved.
10. EE 575: Industrial Control. Prof. Heath presented and made the motion to approve this new course. The motion was seconded by Prof. Royse and unanimously approved.
11. EDC 533: Teaching Reading in the Secondary School. Prof. Lee-Post presented and made the motion to table this course proposal for pending program clarification of whether this should be offered at the 600-level if it is intended for -graduate students only. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.
12. IEC 523: Practicum in Early Childhood Administration and Supervision. Prof. Lee-Post presented and made the motion to table this new course proposal. The program will be asked to submit a revised syllabus that includes grading differentiation for graduate and undergraduate students. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.

13. PHS 632: The Practice of Drug Metabolism. Prof Jackson presented and made the motion to approve this new course proposal. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.
14. PHS 663: Molecular Neurobiology of Abused Drugs. Prof Jackson presented and made the motion to approve this new course proposal. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.
15. PHS 750: Pharmaceutical Sciences Journal Clubs. Prof. Jackson presented and made the motion to approve this new course contingent on agreement from the program to reduce the maximum number of credit hours from ten to five. The motion was seconded by Prof. Berry and unanimously approved.
