Dr. Blackwell presented the proposed changes in the MS in Health Administration Program and all the related courses: (HA 601-Overview of US Health Care Delivery System; HA 602-Organizational Change and Strategic Planning; HA 603-Legal Aspects of Health Administration; HA 604-Managerial Ethics; HA 621-Quantitative Methods of Research; HA 622-Program Evaluation; HA 623-Decision Analysis and Decision Support Systems; HA 624-Information Systems in Health Care; HA 628-Personnel Management in the Health Sector; HA 635-Managerial Accounting; HA 636-Health Economics; HA 637-Health Finance; HA 642-Public Organization, Theory and Behavior; HA 660-Decision Making in Health Care Organizations; HA 673-Health Policy Development). Dr. Blackwell explained that the only change in the formal structure of the program is the reassignment of departmental and college location.
