Prof. Olster made a motion to accept the proposal but withhold formal approval until the final template was presented to Graduate Council for review. At the current meeting, Dean Blackwell presented the latest version of this template. Professor Olster

subsequently made a motion to approve the template for faculty use, which was seconded by Prof. Wasilkowski and unanimously approved.

# 2. Adding GMAT to Admission Requirements

Prof. Jackson presented a request to allow either GRE or GMAT scores to be submitted in support of applications to the graduate programs in Merchandising, Apparel and Textiles and Hospitality Management and Tourism.
