

Applicants to the Graduate School must certify that they have at least \$44,970* available for each twelve-month period of study. Summer school fees are not included. It is estimated that this amount will cover the cost of tuition, fees, books and supplies, room and meals, and health insurance for a single person. The applicant must certify \$7,350.00 per year for a spouse and \$5,040.00 per year for each child entering the United States. These amounts do not include travel expenses. An I-20 or a DS-2019 cannot be issued prior to receipt of acceptable financial information.

Because it is unlawful for non-immigrant students to work in the United States, do not plan to supplement your educational funds in this manner. F-2 visa holders are not permitted to work in the United States and may not pursue a degree, but may enroll in courses in a non degree status.

All students need to arrive with a minimum of \$1,500 or \$2,000 if bringing dependent(s). Self-supported students must have on hand at the beginning of each registration period \$22,485.00 to pay for fees, room rent, meals and health insurance.

Students in the following programs must certify that they have at least the following amount for each 12- month period of study:

- College of Engineering: \$46,020.00
- Communication Sciences and Disorders: \$45,155.00
- Interior Design, Architecture, and Historic Preservation:\$45,770.00
- Master in Accounting: \$47,970.00
- Master of Business Administration, All programs: \$52,584
- Diplomacy and International Commerce: \$45,570.00
- Physician Assistant Studies: \$46,769.00
- Radiological Medical Physics/ Health Physics: \$46,769.00

Two years are allowed for a master's program and eight years for a doctoral program.

** University Housing amount based on efficiency apartment rate. Single occupancy fees may be greater.
