

Student Fellowship Application Materials Checklist

To begin the fellowship application process, you will need to complete the [Online general application](#).

Information/Materials you will need for the general application are:

1. Information on Admission Status
2. Undergraduate GPA
3. Information on GRE Percentile, as well as a scanned copy of unofficial GRE scores (unless waived by your program)
4. A resume/ Curriculum Vitae
5. Copies of Unofficial Transcripts from all schools attended (undergraduate and graduate)
6. Name & Email addresses of 2 Individuals that can serve as references of recommendation for you

After you have successfully completed your general application, specific opportunities may be available.

If you are eligible, a Conditional Application for the Wethington/Matthews/Singletary Fellowships will be available. This application will require the following additional information:

1. Name & Email address of your college advisor
2. A letter of acceptance (if available) to a UK graduate or professional program
3. A personal statement providing background information pertaining to your experiences, accomplishments, and overall strength of candidacy (750-word limit)

If you are eligible, you will be recommended to apply for specific Self-Nominated and/or DGS-Nominated Fellowship opportunities. For these opportunities you will need the following:

1. A personal statement (750-word limit)
2. A fellowship specific DGS Nomination form, signed by your DGS, for each DGS Nominated Fellowship. Copies of these forms can be found below each specific opportunity on the Graduate School's Fellowship page: <http://gradschool.uky.edu/fellowships-0>

For some fellowships, additional materials are required, such as:

1. Cralle Foundation/Joan Cralle Day Fellowship: requires name and email of the chief academic officer at your baccalaureate institution (This person will serve as a reference as well as a provider of information on your degree completion status)
2. McNair Fellowship: requires documentation of participation in McNair Scholars Program (a note from the program's director is preferred)
