# Need to Know

\*For Graduating Master (Plan A & Plan B) and Specialist Students:

### **Degree Audit**

Conducting a <u>DEGREE AUDIT</u> is critically important during the <u>semester you intend to graduate</u>, as it gives you a view of the requirements you have satisfied and those that are remaining!

If you discover a course that was wrongly assigned to a requirement, or not credited, you should bring this to the attention of your <a href="Mossage: DGS (Director of Graduate Studies">DGS (Director of Graduate Studies</a>) or your program advisor. The program should contact the student affairs officer for the area/ discipline well in advance of the final examination to resolve. If there are requirements that have not been met, then you and your program will need to decide it there are substitutions that will fulfill that requirement.
