Timeline

- AMP replaced USP - **Fall '24**
- AMP promotion to undergrads- **Spring '25**
- Direct students to the [interest form](https://go.uky.edu/UKAMP) at go.uky.edu/UKAMP and we'll contact them with instructions to complete the Intent Form.
- AMP **Intent Form** available in **myUK- Spring '25** (to "lock in" their pathway)



Typical length of time to complete a Bachelor's and Master's, rather than 6 years



Earned undergraduate credits needed for program eligibility



Maximum graduate credits an undergrad can earn at no additional cost/free

1 ADVISING APPOINTMENT

They must meet with their advisor.
Conversation points to consider:

- "What semester will you be ready to take a graduate -level course?"
- "Have you met with the graduate program?"
- *"This is not Graduate School admission"*

2 SUBMIT AMP INTENT FORM

Must be **ACCEPTED** by The Graduate School. If not, the grad courses will not count. Stay in contact with grad program. *Application to graduate program is not until Senior year.*

3 TAKE GRAD COURSES & APPLY

Once *approved*, student will have the Non-Degree AMP program of study and corresponding major added to their record in SAP and visible in myUK. AMP Student follows their *undergrad pathway and takes grad courses*, applying to The Grad School their Senior year. 5th year, will be taking all grad courses at the graduate tuition rate.

Important Notes

- If students don't see a particular pathway or major, please consult with the master's program. The program may accept **additional pathways**.
- Some master's programs are 1 year versus 2 years, resulting in **less than 5 years** for completion.
- AMP can be applicable to **online** programs.
- For some master's programs, earning 12 graduate credit hours will simply **reduce** the length of total time in the program, rather than reducing by exactly 1 year.
- Graduate credits:
 - could be applied instead towards a **PhD**.
 - will only count **if** the associated graduate program accepts the credits. Students will not officially apply to the graduate program **until their senior year**.
