The availability of a practicum experience is not assured. As with the academic job market, your area of study, skills, experiences, teaching and research emphasis, and other factors influence your “marketability” as a practicum participant. Availability of practicum positions is influenced by many factors, including the economy. Appropriate combinations of institutional type, course type, semester, hours, etc. may not be possible. It is important to apply for a practicum as early as possible so as to allow sufficient time to connect you with a practicum experience.
