VI. Program Change

1. PhD in Musicology and Ethnomusicology
Several months ago, the School of Music alerted us to an error that arose after the establishment of a new option in their Ph.D. program, Musicology and Ethnomusicology (MUET-PHD). In brief, ALL Ph.D. students began incorrectly receiving a degree in Musicology and Ethnomusicology. At our meeting on April 21, 2011, Graduate Council reviewed and approved a request from the School of Music to return the major back to Music (MUSI-PHD) and create three Options under the MUSI-PHD structure a) Musicology and Ethnomusicology b) Music Theory and c) Music Education. The Senate Council office did not accept the request in simple narrative form, and insisted on a completed Program Change form.
